Pass rates for the exam was 50% (3 out of 6 students). The average scaled score on the exam was 68. The scores in each domain on the exam as follows: Domain #1 Client Consultation and Assessment: 60%. Domain #2 Program Planning: 67%. Domain #3 Techniques of Exercise: 69% and Domain #4 Safety, Emergency, Procedures and Legal Issues: 75%.

What We Learned (areas for improvements, strengths, etc.)

Students scored the lowest on the client consultation and assessment domain on the exam (60%). They scored the highest on the safety, emergency procedures and legal issues domain (75%).

Use of Data to Improve Student Success

"Application for Endowed Teaching Chair has been submitted. This project will allow faculty/staff to create eLearning modules and additional learning support resources for healthcare students to promote "academic wellness," program retention/completion, and national board licensing or certification exam success. Framed as a preventative care plan, modules will integrate learning, study, and test-taking strategies to improve healthcare student preparedness, metacognition, and resilience. In class review sessions and out of class review sessions have been scheduled to also assist students in preparing for the exam."

**Action Plan**

Once the endowed teaching chair project is complete faculty will incorporate these modules and test taking strategies into the course. The instructor is also requiring students to spend a certain amount of time on the Pocket prep app answering test questions every week as a course requirement. Last time the class was offered this was not a requirement but encouraged by the faculty weekly. Students were not spending hardly any time on the APP even with the instructor stressing how important it was. Hopefully this new requirement along with the addition of the other items will assist in improving pass rates.
